### Tuition & Fees

- ❖ If application is received before April 30, Application Fee is \$240.00.
- ❖ Full Tuition is due by 08/08/2011.
- ❖ There is a one time new student Visa processing fee for all 1<sup>st</sup> year students in the amount of \$25.
- ❖ All students must reapply for enrollment each year; the reapplication fee is \$375.

ESL tuition includes an excellent mentor program, which matches American students with international students. Also included in the tuition are three SLEP tests the first year and one TOEFL test the second year. There may be minimal additional fees for elective classes.

International students take ESL classes based on their English language proficiency. Students need to score at least 71 on the Internet Based TOEFL (iBT) to graduate out of the ESL program. (There is a tuition reduction for those students that have graduated out of the ESL program.) Students who score 62 or higher on the SLEP Test will only be required to take two ESL classes. (See International Student Handbook for more details.)

### Mandatory Health Insurance

All international students at PAA are required to have year-round extended health insurance by Oregon State Law (Oregon Administrative Rule #577-30-080). There are two choices

- ❖ PAA's international insurance provider
  - \$500,000 coverage, with a \$50 co-pay
  - Estimated cost: \$75.00 per month, payable in full by 08/08/2011.
- ❖ Private insurance
  - In order for private insurance to meet US Government requirements, proof of the following minimum coverage is required:
    - \$50,000 for each accident or illness
    - \$10,000 for medical evacuation
    - \$7,500 for repatriation of mortal remains

### Refund Policy

If, for some reason, a student is unable to attend PAA, tuition will be reimbursed as follows:

- ❖ Full Refund - If the student withdraws from school before school starts.
- ❖ Partial Refund - If a student withdraws after school begins, only subsequent semesters will be refunded. This reflects the fact that the student had occupied an enrollment spot during the current semester that can not be filled by another student until the start of the next semester.
- ❖ Students who graduate out of ESL will be refunded the difference between the ESL and International rate on a prorated basis.

### One Quarter Audit

International students intending to attend PAA in the fall come in April for an eight-week preview program, auditing the existing ESL classes.
