PAA GRADE POLICY

The athletic department would further like to clarify its position on grades and play eligibility:

- No player may participate with more than one D listed in their grades.
- Any player with an F will not be allowed to travel with the team.
- Any player with an F will be disqualified from playing games.
- Coach or AD may hold player out of practice for bad grades.
- Game eligibility must be cleared by noon or at the conclusion of lunch of game day through the teacher and the athletic department.
- Ineligibility begins the day following the teacher's notification

COUGAR ATHLETIC SUBSTANCE CONTRACT

- I. I will not consume any drugs, alcohol, or tobacco.
- II. I will not knowingly ride in a motor vehicle whose driver has used any chemical that alters the body's natural state.
- III. I will not knowingly attend any event where drugs and alcohol are present or are being used. If this situation does occur, I will immediately remove myself from this situation.
- IV. I will comply with the Student Code of Conduct that governs Portland Adventist Academy students.
- V. I understand that a violation of these rules will result in immediate suspension from athletics at Portland Adventist Academy.

PAA HAZING POLICY

Definition of Hazing

Hazing occurs when an act is committed against a student or a student is coerced into committing an act that creates a substantial risk or harm to the student or to any third party in order for the student to be initiated into or affiliated with an school group, club, athletics team, grade level, activity or organization. Hazing includes but is not limited to:

- Any activity involving an unreasonable risk of physical harm, including padding, beating, whipping, branding, electrical shock, sleep deprivation, exposure to weather, placement of harmful substances on the body, and participation in physically dangerous activities.
- Any activity involving the consumption of alcohol, drugs, tobacco products, or any other food, liquid, or other substance that subjects the student to an unreasonable risk of physical harm.
- Any activity involving actions of a sexual nature or the simulation of actions of a sexual nature.
- Any activity that subjects a student to an extreme and unreasonable level of embarrassment, shame, or humiliation or which creates a hostile abusive, or intimidating environment.
- Any activity involving any violation of federal, state or local law or any violations of school polices and regulations.

Hazing is not acceptable at any level and the athletic department will deal with Hazing on an individual basis. All Hazing incidents will be reported to school counselor
